He completed a residency in radiation oncology at The University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston, Texas. He also has a M.A. in Biomedical Ethics from Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio. His academic accomplishments include the publication of several significant studies in the medical community. He was instrumental in developing and implementing best-practice guidelines for the use of SBRT for all MD Anderson satellite facilities around the country.

The radiation oncologists are faculty at MD Anderson Cancer Center. Their support staff receive their training from MD Anderson. All cases treated in Albuquerque are reviewed by MD Anderson Cancer Center physicians in Houston.
